

I realize there are more uttermost than Kalinowan village 6 driving hours from our compound, but this remote village is the uttermost part of our world. Some of our grads have been ministering there for several years and love every opportunity to go and minister among these folks. We have total liberty there and are beloved by most of the local population.

They have a strong Seventh Day Adventist presence there along with several other confused and mixed-up theologies, both current, as well as millennia old. We have superimposed sound doctrine over top of all this confusion which produces an admixture that is not quickly embraced.

Because of our faithfulness in this ministry the good Lord opened a door to a potentially very fruitful ministry. We designed a crash course structured around our three-year Bible Institute curriculum. It is ten days of intense study in the very subjects most needed in that village. Those being, authority of the Word of God, baptism, eternal Security, and the Holy Spirit vs. unclean spirits.

We brought two good men down to our compound here for the curation of this crash course. Both men are in their mid-forties. After both Silver and Jimmy finished their course and graduated, we have now returned them to their village with a strong challenge from 2Tim. 2:2. We also took them on their first street meeting.

They are both very accepted and influential there and so we are very eager to see much fruit grow as a result of this planting. Mae and Alvin, one of our couples who work with us here, have made several trips there and feel the leading of the Lord to begin a long-term work there. This will now be much smoother since this ground-breaking effort with the crash course.
