Normally we have another service at 2 PM but once a month we all travel into downtown Cagayan de Oro for a great, church-wide street meeting. Last Sunday we had about 35.

Back on the compound, we have youth fellowship and then free time...whew We enjoyed having you visit us today...come again.

WELL.....after digging 86 feet straight down (see pic) we have stuck water. Since we first moved onto the compound, we have had a complicated water supply as well as questionable bills depending upon the whims of the local elected officials. This was well needed, and we rejoice in the completion.

Public ministry is spreading to other local churches through our influence, and we love to see this happening.
